#### Changes to Notice of Race

**Please note the following changes apply to the 2024 Brisbane to Gladstone Race Notice of Race:**

#### **Clause 1.2 – Other Documents**

**Add:** h. the Gladstone Ports Corporation, Ports Notices and Rules, including Small Vessel Reporting Requirements when entering the Port of Gladstone. – ([Gladstone Port Procedures and Information for Shipping \(Maritime Safety Queensland\) \(msq.qld.gov.au\)](https://www.msq.qld.gov.au/))

#### **Clause 1.7 – Changes to Australian Sailing Special Regulations**

**Item SR 4.07.9 – Delete** “Codeine 8mg + Paracetamol 500mg (Prescription) e.g. Panadeine X 20” from the list of required items.

#### **Clause 8.2 – Identification**

Please delete Clause 8.2 in its entirety and replace with:

Clause 8.2 - Identification

Entrants will be asked via the online entry system to provide their boat’s permanent bow numbers if they have them.

#### **Clause 10 – Briefing**

Delete Clause 10 in its entirety and replace with:

Clause 10 – Compulsory Briefing

The compulsory Race Briefing will be held at 8.30pm sharp on Wednesday 27th March at Queensland Cruising Yacht Club, Sinbad St, Shorncliffe QLD 4017.

In order to be eligible to start the race, at least two crew members of each boat are required to attend the briefing in person, one attendee shall be the Owner or Person-in-Charge.

Queensland Cruising Yacht Club will be open from 5.30pm. All skippers and crews, along with partners, are welcome for pre-briefing drinks and finger food prior to the briefing.
